Dr. Angel Reyna



Dr. Ángel Reyna officially took over as president of Madera and Oakhurst College Centers (now Madera Community College) on May 20, 2019, a little bit of history came with it, as he is the first on-campus president in school history. Dr. Reyna comes to the Central Valley from Renton (WA) Technical College, where he served as Vice President of Instruction since December of 2015. Prior to that, he served as Dean of Workforce Education at Walla Walla Community College and Director for Workforce Education and ESL adjunct instructor at Yakima Valley Community College. Dr. Reyna has a very diverse resume, having served as mayor of the City of Mabton, Washington from 2010-2013 and a city councilmember from 2006-2009. He also worked as a seasonal migrant farmworker in the state of Washington for 13 years. President Reyna recently completed his doctorate in organizational leadership at Northeastern University. He previously earned his M.A. in Educational Administration and B.A. in History and Education from Washington State University. Dr. Ángel Reyna was selected, through a highly competitive process, as one of the 25 leaders for the 2021-22 class of the Aspen New Presidents Fellowship.
